

Mobile Staging Addendum to Klassic Sound Rental Agreement & Service Agreement

- A Klassic Sound, LLC, hereinafter referred to as (KS), representative will deliver, setup, and remove the mobile stage at the times and location specified in the Production Agreement for the specified total rental price.
- Customer warrants and represents that the Job Site has sufficient space to support a mobile stage in length: 50', width: 8'6" and height: 13'6", a truck weighing 13 tons, and a stage weighing 10 tons.
- If union labor is required at any time related to this agreement Lessee agrees to incur the cost of any and all associated union labor and fees.
- Rigging plans must be submitted no less than (1) week prior to load in for approval. Rigging to stage is not allowed without prior approval.
- The first two hours for delivery and setup are included in the Rental Price. Lessee will pay \$100.00 per hour after the two hour limit, time to begin at the load in time specified in the Production Agreement.
- If deemed necessary for KS to move the mobile stage at any time during the rental period, additional costs may be incurred.
- Upon delivery and setup of the mobile stage, the Lessee shall be responsible for the safety of the users of the mobile stage and all persons in the area of the mobile stage.
- The Lessee shall be responsible for discontinuing the use of the stage where conditions render the continued use of the stage unsafe.
- Lessee is responsible for monitoring wind speeds and abiding by the guidelines set forth in the high wind action plan.
- At no time will the Lessee move, remove, reconfigure, adjust, or alter the mobile stage without the prior consent of KS personnel.
- The Lessee is responsible for the security of the stage until the strike time listed on the Production Agreement. If the Lessee ends their event earlier than the time specified the Lessee will notify KS and safeguard the stage until a KS representative arrives. For multiple day rental of the stage, renter agrees to provide security for the stage during all overnight hours when the stage is not in use.
- In the event the strike time is postponed from the strike time specified in the Production Agreement, Lessee will pay \$100.00 per hour until the stage is ready to be removed.
- The mobile stage is not a public accommodation with the meaning of the Americans With Disabilities Act ("ADA"). If the Renter intends to use the portable stage at a public accommodation it is the Lessee's responsibility to insure compliance with the ADA. This Agreement shall not be amended, modified, revised, or terminated except by further written agreement signed by Lessee and Lessor. The Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts and/or by facsimile, each of which shall be deemed to be an original and all of which together shall be deemed to be one and the same instrument.

By signing, Company and Customer agree to the above terms and conditions as an extension of the Rental and Service Agreement. Each warrants to the other that the person signing below has full authority to enter into this Agreement and/or sign this Agreement on behalf of a corporate or like business entity.
